


Spring Cleaning Time!

As many of you are aware, we have an open door for ministry at Wellsprings Therapy center in Gilbert. We visit them every Sunday to hold a service. We also bring a group of families to do room to room visitation the third Wednesday of the month. It has been a marvelous way to bring a word of hope, a Scripture to encourage them, a song to inspire their hearts, and we even have one young man that tells them a joke or two. Volunteers make blankets and sweet crafts, children paint pictures and everyone is encouraged as we distribute these humble treasures. We also bring sweets and treats for the staff. It is a very productive outreach. Just this morning a resident cried to Tom in despair. While conducting Bible study at his church, he suffered a stroke. He could not understand how the Lord could allow this tragedy as he is primary caretaker for his very sick wife and is now wheelchair bound. He needed a listening ear; he needed someone to bring hope to him! A family thanked us recently for helping to fill the gap while their grandma was in recovery at Wellspring and unable to attend church. A Jewish woman recently told

us that she would consider looking into Jesus as the Messiah of Israel and received some literature to help her with that search. Jeff and Jackie Chamberlain have been conducting services in our absence for several years now. We would like to thank them for their willing service. They have their own stories to tell of ministry time at Wellspring. We need more helpers like them who find it a joy to minister to the residents of Wellspring. It is humbling to see the frail conditions of these residents and sometimes we stumble upon someone with a cranky disposition but every open door makes it worth it!

We don't always know how many will attend the services or which rooms will welcome our little ones as they come bearing gifts but every week brings an opportunity to share the gospel in word and deed. 
Outreach to Single Moms
